In collaboration with Archives' staff and partners, the **Communications & Outreach Manager** will develop and implement strategies to help grow TAF's membership; connect with receptive audiences at local, national, and international scales; and spread awareness about The Archives as a leading global research institution. The role will assist the Executive Director to design and implement successful fundraising campaigns, thinking and acting strategically in a competitive donor environment. Working on and off-site, this position will respond to general inquiries and assist with public interpretive work as needed to support regular visitors and scheduled events.
